



## Berwick Springs Cricket Club – Online Registration Instructions

### 1. Background

As from the 2019-20 cricket season, all Junior registrations are now required to be completed online, as per a directive from Cricket Victoria. In keeping with this practice, Senior registrations will also be available via the same method. The club will also be holding registration days, where this process can be assisted, and merchandise can be ordered.

Following is a step by step guide on how to complete the online registration.

### 2. Player Categories

Prospective players, Junior or Senior, will fall into one of four categories, the registration process differs a little depending on this.

1. Returning players, currently registered with Berwick Springs. This includes players who have not played for several seasons, but their LAST MATCH was for the club.
  2. Players whose LAST MATCH was for ANOTHER club, regardless of any previous affiliation with Berwick Springs.
  3. New players, never previously registered with ANY club.
- Players in Categories 1 and 2 will have a MyCricket ID number, usually 6 or 7 digits. This is important as it is used to identify a player and all records are kept against that number. Players should NOT have more than one ID. This number is used to register online.
  - Category 2 players MUST contact the club prior to registration, so the transfer or clearance can be actioned. Email the club before commencing registration.
  - Category 3 players will not have a MyCricket ID and can skip the next step.

### 3. Determine MyCricket ID

Type your name into the relevant fields, and click SEARCH. A list of players with the same and similar names will appear. Find yourself and make note of the ID number in the left hand column. If you have played at several clubs you will be listed more than once, but the number should be the same.

1. Registrations are done through the Playcricket website. The link below takes you straight to our registration start page.

4. **a) New Players** - Players that haven't played before, and have no MyCricket ID, click on the continue button at the bottom and follow the prompts to complete a new registration. You will be asked to enter all personal information.

**b) Returning players with a MyCricket ID**

If you have previously registered with MyCricket, enter your ID number and password and click Login, and go to Step 4. Unless you have registered online previously, it is unlikely you will have a login.

If you haven't previously registered, click on 'Skip this Step'. You will be prompted to enter personal details, one of which is an email address. This **MUST** be the email address you have registered with the club, and is required to verify your account. If unsure you can check with the club Secretary. Once your account is verified you will be able to login and complete the registration process.



5. Continue to step through each page entering information as requested. New registrations will have to enter all the information. Re-registering player, fields will be auto-populated. Please check all information is correct, amend as necessary.
6. You will come to a Terms and Conditions page. Read all carefully, and check the boxes to continue. Any relevant club documents are available on our website, and there are links to MyCricket and Cricket Australia's documents.

10. Players from other clubs will require a clearance, this will be requested by the club.
